As per the Clause 'Power to Modify' laid down under Chapter-II Ordinance-12-18 and in pursuance to the discussions held between the University Authorities and Principals and Senior Faculty of various affiliated colleges in one day workshop on the topic "Choice Based Credit System-Issues and Challenges" held on 14<sup>th</sup> September,2016 and subsequent representations received, the Vice-Chancellor granted one time exemption in respect of the condition of CGPA and credit for progression to 3<sup>rd</sup> semester of various courses under Engineering (UG&PG), Pharmacy (UG&PG), MBA and MCA under Choice Based Credit System for the academic session 2016-17, keeping in view, the larger interest of students.
