Statement of the Chairman

At the outset, the Chairman welcomed all the members of Academic Council. Item No. 24.2 To consider and approve to start Ph.D programme in Computer Science Engineering under the School of Engineering & Technology in Himachal Pradesh Technical University campus at Hamirpur

As per sub-section (a) of Section 4 of the Himachal Pradesh Technical University Act, 2014 the objects of the University shall be to develop the knowledge of science, engineering and technology, management and environment by teaching, research, experimentation or practical training or such other means as the University may deem fit for the advancement of quality of life of the mankind. The Himachal Pradesh Technical University under sub-section (b) of Section 5 of the ibid Act has the power to frame Statute, Ordinances and Regulation for carrying out the objects of the University in accordance with the provisions of the ibid Act.

The Ordinances for various Ph.D. Programmes made by the Academic Council in exercise of powers vested under sub-section (a) of Section 20 of the Himachal Pradesh Technical University Act and the same have been approved by the Board of Governors in its 13th meeting in exercise of powers vested under sub-section (d) of Section 17 of ibid Act. The University has accordingly notified the Ordinances for Ph.D. vide Notification No. HimTu-1(GA)-3/2011-2971 dated 21.03.2016 (copy placed as Annexure- II)

After detailed discussions for development of research activities at University and College level, the Academic Council approved to start Ph.D programme under the School of Engineering & Technology in Himachal Pradesh Technical University campus at Hamirpur in accordance with the University Grant Commission Regulations for awarding Ph.D degree.

Therefore, the University had conducted the walk in interviews for engagement of Guest/Part time faculty purely on lecture basis for the above programmes. The University declared the result and engaged Dr. Vipan Kumar Bhulal and Shri Dheeraj Sonkhla in the Department of MBA and M.C.A. respectively on the approved rates in order of merit as Guest/Part time faculty for the smooth running of the above courses.

The Academic Council considered and approved the engagement of Dr. Vipan Kumar Bhulal in the Department of MBA and Shri Dheeraj Sonkhla in the Department of MCA. The application on the prescribed form should be submitted to the University within 21 days of starting of session of 3 rd semester (5 th semester in case of lateral entry) alongwith No Objection Certificate (NOC) from both the institutions.

During the meeting it was pointed out that the Dean-cum-TEQIP-III Coordinator, H.P Technical University, Hamirpur vide e-mail dated 3rd September, 2019 (copy placed as Annexure-XXXI) requested the Academic Consultant, NPIU to permit the University to engage two additional manpower i.e. one additional Project Officer (preferably Engineering background) and One Assistant, HR (graduation in any subject with good typing speed and computer knowledge) for entire project duration. In response to the above e-mail, Academic Consultant, NPIU, Ministry of HRD, Government of India vide e-mail dated 3rd September, 2019 (copy placed as Annexure-XXXII) conveyed the NPIU concurrence on the appointment of proposed manpower with certain conditions mentioned in the e-mail.

It was also pointed out in the meeting that since the project is on the completion stage and as such Data Entry Operators are more useful and proposed to engage two Data Entry Operators instead of Project Officer and Assistant HR on outsource basis subject to fulfillment of other conditions as laid down in the e-mail dated 3rd September, 2019 received from the Academic Consultant, NPIU.

After detailed deliberations, the Academic Council considered and allowed the University to engage two Data Entry Operators on outsource basis under TEQIP-III Project for the project period only by observing other conditions conveyed by Academic Consultant, NPIU through e-mail dated 3rd September, 2019.
