ORDINANCE NO: 61

AFFILIATION AND RECOGNITION OF COLLEGES AND INSTITUTIONS

(Under Section 35 of the Himachal Pradesh Technical University Act 2014)  
(Approved by the Board of Governors and the Academic Council in their meetings held on 25/7/2015 and 21/7/2015 respectively)

Short title.	1.	These Ordinances may be called the Himachal Pradesh Technical University Affiliation Ordinances, 2014.
Commencement	2.	They shall come into force from the date of their notification issued by the University.
Definitions.	3.	In these Ordinances, unless the context otherwise requires;-
	(a)	"Act" means the Himachal Pradesh Technical University Act, 2014;
	(b)	"AICTE" means All India Council for Technical Education.
	(c)	"Board" means the Board of Governors of the University;
	(d)	"College" means an affiliated college, autonomous college and constituent college or any other college by whatever name called;
	(e)	"Government" means the Government of Himachal Pradesh.
	(f)	"Institution" means an institution, organization, training centre or other establishment providing teaching, research, experimentation of practical training in engineering, technology, physical and social science and includes a polytechnic;
	(g)	"Teachers" includes Directors, Professors, Readers, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors, Lecturers in a college or University and such other persons giving instructions in a college or University as may be declared by the Statutes to be teachers;
	(h)	"University" means the Himachal Pradesh Technical University, as constituted under this Ordinance;
	(i)	"UGC" means University Grants Commission.
Applicability	4.	Subject to the provisions contained in the University Act, these

		(l)	The college shall be managed by a duly constituted Governing Council. The composition, functions and other conditions pertaining to the Governing Council shall be as prescribed in the Regulations.  However, the constitution of Governing Council for government college is not mandatory.
		(m)	The Registered Society/Trust seeking affiliation shall be required to submit an affidavit as specified in Schedule-I on a judicial paper of Rs. 100/- duly sworn before an Executive Magistrate.
		(n)	Notwithstanding anything mentioned above the other terms and conditions for affiliation shall be as laid down in the Act, Statutes and Ordinances of the University.
	7.	Financial requirement and Utilization of Funds & Audit:-	
		(a)	A non-government institute shall have endowment fund to the extent decided and notified by the University from time to time to run the institute for at least three years without aid from external sources subject to a minimum of Rs. 15/- lac per program.
		(b)	Endowment fund shall be maintained in either of the two modes:-
		(i)	In the name of the institute by way of government securities.
		(ii)	FDR of Nationalized Bank held by the institute and pledged to the University.
		(c)	The amounts under any head collected by the college from the students shall be expended solely for the betterment and growth of the college and to provide facilities for the benefit of the students and staff of the college.
		(d)	The college shall submit its statement of accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant to the University every year and also submit the financial details in the prescribed format as given in the Regulations.
Procedure for granting	8.	Every newly established institute or existing self-financed institute set up by a trust/society shall be granted temporary affiliation for a	



Temporary/Provisional affiliation		period of one academic year in the first instance. This process of granting provisional affiliation will be repeated every year for a minimum number of years as prescribed in the Regulations.

**CONDITIONS TO BE FULFILLED BY THE  
ACADEMIC TRAINING INSTITUTION**

- 1) Any authority or institution in India applying to the Pharmacy Council of India for approval of courses of study for Pharm.D. and Pharm.D. (Post Baccalaureate) under sub-section (1) of section 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 shall comply with the infrastructural facilities as prescribed by the Pharmacy Council of India from time to time.
- 2) Pharm.D. and Pharm.D. (Post Baccalaureate) programmes shall be conducted only in those institutions which -
  - a) are approved by the Pharmacy Council of India for B.Pharm course as provided under section 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948;
  - b) have 300 bedded hospital attached to it.
    - (i) **Hospital Details**
      1. Institution with their own hospital of minimum 300 beds.
      2. Teaching hospital recognised by the Medical Council of India or University, or a Government hospital not below the level of district headquarter hospital with 300 beds with clearly defined Memorandum of Understanding including housing pharmacy practice department with minimum carpet area of 30 square feet per student along with consent to provide the professional manpower to support the programme.
      3. Corporate type hospital with minimum 300 beds with clearly defined Memorandum of Understanding including housing pharmacy practice department with minimum carpet area of 30 square feet per student along with consent to provide the professional manpower to support the programme.
      4. Number of institutions which can be attached to one hospital shall be restricted by the student pharmacist to bed ratio of 1:10.
    - (ii) **Speciality**
      - a) Tertiary care hospitals are desirable
      - b) Medicine[compulsory], and any three specialization of the following
        1. Surgery
        2. Pediatrics
        3. Gynecology and obstetrics
        4. Psychiatry
        5. Skin and VD
        6. Orthopedics
    - (iii) **Location of the Hospital**

Within the same limits of Corporation or Municipality or Campus with Medical Faculty involvement as adjunct faculty.





### 3) TEACHING STAFF REQUIREMENT

- i) Staff Pattern : All faculty shall be full time. However part time perceptors in hospital shall be allowed.

### 5) ACCOMMODATION :

Suitable and sufficient accommodation with adequate ventilation, lighting and other hygienic conditions should be provided to the rooms for Principal or the Head of the department, office, class rooms, library, staff, staff common room, students common room, museum, laboratories, stores, etc.

At least two lecture halls alongwith eight laboratories as specified below should be provided for: —

1. Pharmaceutics and Pharmacokinetics Lab	- 2
2. Life Science (Pharmacology, Physiology, Pathophysiology)	- 2
3. Phytochemistry or Pharmaceutical Chemistry	- 2
4. Pharmacy Practice	- 2

Total = 8

In addition to the laboratories, balance room, aseptic room or cabinet, animal house and a machine room shall also be provided.

Floor area of the laboratory should not be less than 30 square feet per student required to work in the laboratory at any given time subject to a minimum of 750 square feet.

Laboratories should be fitted and constructed in a manner that these can be kept reasonably clean. Gas and water fittings, shelves, fuming cupboards be provided wherever necessary.

4. **Objects of the University.**—Subject to such law as may be made by Parliament as to co-ordination and determination of standards in Institutions for higher education or research and scientific and Technical Institutions or subject to such directions as may, from time to time, be given in regard thereto by or on behalf of the Central Government, the objects of the University shall be—

- (a) to develop the knowledge of science, engineering and technology, management and environment by teaching, research, experimentation or practical training or such other means as the University may deem fit for the advancement of quality of life of the mankind;
- (b) to supply the required skilled manpower of appropriate kind and quality to meet the needs of society and national development plans;
- (c) to develop patterns of teaching and training at various levels of educational accomplishment so as to set high standards of education in science, engineering and technology;
- (d) to derive benefits from the ever growing scientific and technological knowledge in different parts of the world and to advance frontiers of knowledge by research, innovation, invention and product development;
- (e) to establish close linkage with Industry to make teaching, training and research in the University relevant to the needs of society and industry at national and international level;
- (f) to establish, maintain and manage Colleges, Schools, Departments, Centers of Research and other Institutions necessary to carry out the objects of the University;
- (g) to affiliate or recognize Colleges or Institutions within and outside the State of Himachal Pradesh; and
- (h) to function as a leading resource Centre for knowledge management and entrepreneurship development in the area of Science and Technology.

5. **Power of the University.**—Subject to the provisions of this Act and such conditions as may be prescribed by the Statutes, the Ordinances and the Regulations, the University shall exercise the following powers and discharge the functions namely:—

- (a) to establish and manage such Schools/Departments or Centres of Excellence for education and research as are necessary for the furtherance of the objects of the University;
- (b) to frame Statutes, Ordinances and Regulations for carrying out the objects of the University in accordance with the provisions of this Act;
- (c) to provide for education, research and training in such branches of Engineering and Technology, Sciences, Pharmacy, Management and Arts, as the University may deem fit, for the advancement and dissemination of knowledge in such branches;
- (d) to seek collaborations with other academic Institutions or Universities on mutually acceptable terms and conditions;
