
2. In this series NSO plans to hold 17th National Seminar on the subjects covered during NSS 75th Round (July 2017- June 2018), i.e. on the following subject:

3. For 75th Round, a total of four reports (including Key Indicators) and corresponding unit level data have been released. The NSS Reports are available free of cost on the website is as follow:


