#### Statement of the Chairman

The students in their representations have also stated that as per the AICTE Approval Process Handbook 2020-21 the entry level qualifications for taking admission under lateral entry scheme has been amended as "Passed diploma examination with at least 45% marks (40% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in any Branch of Engineering and Technology" from the academic session 2020-21.

Keeping in view the entry level qualifications laid down by the AICTE as stated above as well as larger interest of the students, the Academic Council after detailed discussions considered and approved that a candidate who has passed three years Architecture Diploma examination with at least 45% marks (40% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) may take admission in Civil Engineering under lateral entry scheme from the academic session 2020-21 as the nomenclature of Diploma in Architecture and Civil Engineering is same.
